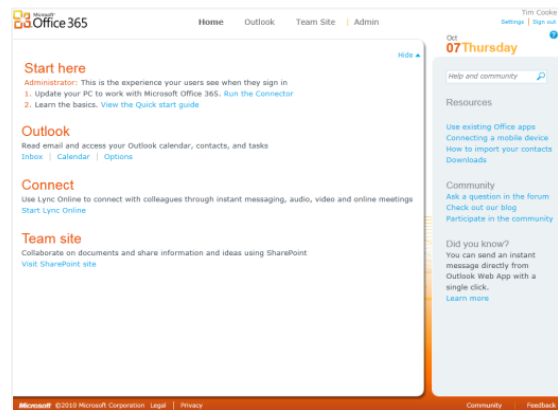
Improved Collaboration

Email, Calendar, and Contacts

Powered by Microsoft Exchange Online

- Take advantage of large, 25-GB mailboxes and the ability to send messages up to 25 MB in size.
- Automatically update email, calendar, and contacts across commonly used devices, including PC, Macintosh, Windows® Phone, iPhone, certain Android models, and BlackBerry Internet Service.¹
- Connect with Microsoft Outlook 2010 or 2007 and use rich Outlook functionality whether on the Internet or offline.
- Access email, calendars, and contacts from nearly any web browser while keeping a rich, familiar experience with Outlook Web App.²

¹ Users of BlackBerry Internet Service get push email and can add calendar and contacts to their BlackBerry devices through a wired sync with Outlook on the PC. Access from mobile devices depends on carrier network availability.

- Use presence information to see when colleagues and partners are online and available.
